Salbutamol inhalers

Our protocol states that patients must be taking Salbutamol in order to be eligible.

Please note that this includes inhalers such as Ventolin, Salbulin, and Salamol (amongst others). As long as the active ingredient is Salbutamol Sulfate, in 100mcg per actuation, they are eligible and can be invited/included.
